- Web graphic that moves
- it has multiple frames encoded into a single image file
- GIF can loop endlessly
- GIF can only be one or few sequences long
- to make a GIF you ´ll only need 2 pictures, but a careful planning can produce a cool graphic image

- when you jump, then it can be shown as one floats
- nice effect can be achieved through perspective - someone is moving away or towards the camera
- if possible avoid using digital effects (and text)
